Buddy Bench

A red bench, blue bench to correspond with the color in the park. Next Smencil sale will go towards these. Benches cost \$450 each. District will install. Vote on the maximum - what is raised with the Smencil sale. Maureen Hartwig asked how will the staff support this. Emily Lech said the social emotional teaching will be rolling out once a week starting next year. Next step is buying a bench, one for 2nd, 5th, kindergarten and front doors. A family can purchase the bench and get a plaque near the bench. Those benches are \$469 plus the cost of the plaque. Carolyn mentioned, what about a fundraiser from the class of 2016 for one bench. Jeanette said we will promote it and in the past one family block said they will buy one. Voting will be at next meeting to see if purchasing more benches. Voting is ongoing for a Franklin mascot. Emily Lech said a new principle would be a good opportunity to be involved in the picking a mascot. The Rocks Theme will be continued...however there is a Social Emotional Comittee for the district...does everyone do something like a researched based idea. One idea is a check in coach...who can be anyone at the school. See them in them in the morning then see them at the end of the day

Hot Lunch Program

PTA had a choice of 28 days a year or have the district take over. Estimated price was \$3.50 a meal and survey showed families were not interested in sustainable items. Every PTA needs to vote and would cost each PTA \$10,000 to be paid over 3 years. Arbor is the company and may put the cost of the items built into the cost of the food. It goes back to the School Board, then local PTA board. It will be either no more lunch program or pay back the lunch program. Dr. Heinz meeting is beginning of May, and Franklin PTA meeting is the end of the month. It will need to go to a vote at that time. Washington is ready to vote and write the check, Roosevelt is against it. It needs to be district wide.

Jeanette said she is planning on putting something for Mr. Walsh's last week and looking for ideas and volunteers.

Buddy benches were unanimous in voting yes to pass.
