Franklin students will have a HALLOWEEN PARADE (weather permitting) and parties on WED. Oct. 31st. The ALL SCHOOL parade will take place outside at 2:20 p.m. Children will change into their costumes at 1:00 and then we will start our classroom parties. Kindergarten students can wear their costumes to school. Classroom parties will be held from 1:20 - 2:20 p.m. Our parade route will have students exiting the building through the circle driveway doors (Door 3), walking the perimeter of the school across the playground and entering the school at Door 9.
